Marcel cites classic guitarists such as Jimmy Page, Jimi Hendrix, David Gilmour, Keith Richards, Eric Clapton, Carlos Santana, Albert King and Stevie Ray Vaughan as key influences.

With a solid background of performing, recording and session work in Montreal, Marcel's outstanding guitar work, coupled with Bruce's innovative bass lines, provides for the rock solid core to Kingston Rogues' compelling sound.

Born in Halifax, NS, Bruce brings almost 50 years performing and recording experience to the band. He has toured throughout Europe and Canada. He has played with such notables as Canada's legendary "prime minister of the blues", Dutch Mason, Jeff Healey, Jerome Godboo, Morgan Davis and John Campbelljohn.

He is the newest member of Kingston Rogues and brings with him 30 years of experience. Together with Bruce on bass, Chris provides a solid backbeat for the band.

He has also played with Crazy Babies (an Ozzy/ Sabbath tribute band); Rock Bottom; and local singer/songwriters Fraz Milne and Tim Lenehan among others.
